The following is the status of the New York State Military Emergency Boat Service

1) ADMINISTRATION:

- a. The State Active Duty request function in MEBS LOG has been repaired. All requests for SAD are to be submitted using the SAD Request Tab in either MEBS LOG or the NYNM OPERATIONS apps. A written step-by-step procedure has been added to the Training page on the NYNM website https://dmna.ny.gov/nynm/training/Requesting Orders In NYNM OPERATIONS APP.pdf.
- b. Applications for Naval Militia 900-series promotion are due to headquarters by 15MAY24.
- c. Whenever a MEBS truck (not located at Leeds) is used, the driver must log the event on the Vehicle Usage Log, take a picture of the page and submit it using the MILEAGE function in MEBS LOG.

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- d. We have been notified that the proposed purchase of a 30-foot landing craft in this new year state budget was not approved. We are not working to acquire a new boat. The line has been removed from our SFY25 NPS expenditures below.
- e. The TV Show "Full Measure" is planning to do a piece on the Naval Militia. We have offered shoot dates in June (4,5,11,12,18, or19) in New York City.
